**MANAGER'S MEMO**

In July, New Hampshire Public Television passed an important benchmark. For the first time in our history, more people tuned to NHPTV at least once each week than to any other New Hampshire television station, public or otherwise.

This does not mean that we've suddenly become a ratings leader. The number of you watching us at any specific time is usually less than for our New Hampshire commercial colleagues, particularly in prime time. It does mean, however, that in the course of the typical week, our highly diverse schedule serves a broader cross section of viewers than do other local stations. It also confirms that we are serving all the people, not just a specialized few.

One observer commented that public television programming is a mile wide and a foot deep; that while we may not attract lots of viewers at any given moment, our cumulative reach is quite broad. This, we believe, is as it should be. You may not watch us as often as commercial television, but the average 2 to 3 hours per week you do spend with us is *quality* time. We at NHPTV are dedicated to keeping it that way. We also thank you for your financial support and for taking the time to write and call in our comments and reactions.
