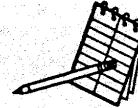

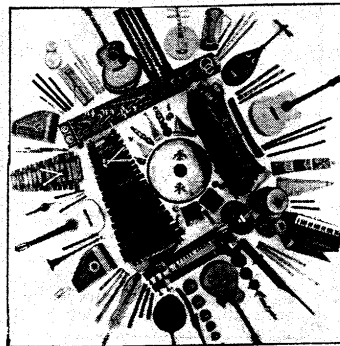
Featured performers will be **Unu Mondo!**, playing a variety of cultural music styles on authentic instruments. The concert will begin at 5 p.m. and is free
